## The Memorandum of Understanding between Jagiellonian University in Kraków,Faculty of Chemistry, and Institute for Catalysis, Hokkaido University

Faculty of Chemistry, Jagiellonian University in Kraków and Institute for Catalysis, Hokkaido University hereby conclude this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to promote friendship and academic exchange between the two institutions.

- 1) Both institutions agree to an academic exchange in the areas of catalysis chemistry, surface science and its related area for education and research.
- 2) Both institutions will make an effort to exchange faculty members, research fellows and students and also exchange research materials and publications.
- 3) Both institutions will make an effort to promote this friendship exchange but will respect the independence of opinion to our mutual benefit. Each institution will be responsible for financing its own activities in Section 1 and 2. In order to carry out the exchange, a separate Cooperation Agreement will be signed after mutual consultation between the parties.
- 4) The MoU shall come into effect on the date of the signatures to the MoUand shall be valid for a period of five years. It will thereafter be automatically renewed every five years subsequently unless either institution notifies its intention of termination at least 3 months prior to the expiration date.
- 5) This MoU is to be executed in English language in two (2) original copies, with one (1) copy for each institution. All copies shall have equal validity.
